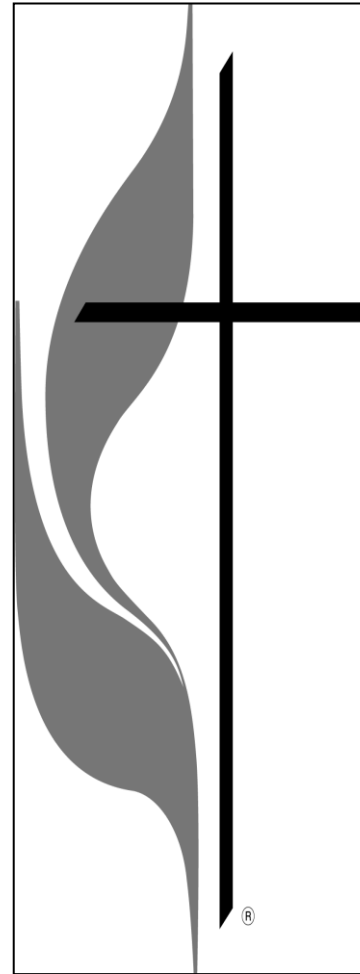

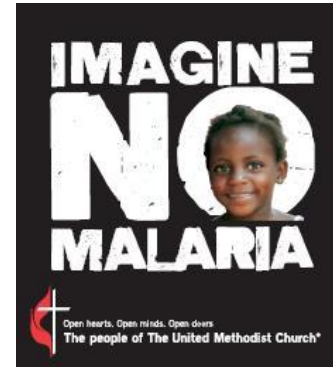

Every 30 seconds, an innocent child in Africa dies of malaria.

WE have a chance to make a difference.

Imagine No Malaria is an extraordinary effort by The United Methodist Church to eliminate malaria as a major source of death and suffering in Africa by 2015.

Imagine...a mosquito bite causing fever, vomiting, convulsions and death.

Imagine watching only half your children grow to adulthood.

Now, imagine a world where families don't lose mothers, brothers, daughters and sons due to malaria.

It's possible, and together we can make it a reality. How?

- Prevention: Distributing insecticide- treated bed nets (Nothing But Nets), and working to drain standing water where mosquitoes breed.
- Education: Teaching people how to effectively use bed nets and how best to protect themselves from malaria.
- Communication: Using radio and cell phones to deliver lifesaving information about malaria.
- Treatment: Improving access to care by training community-based health workers, and delivering life- saving medicines so hospitals and clinics can care for those in need.

Malaria affects more than 500 million people each year, taking more than a million innocent lives.

Please join us in this fight as we work toward a day when malaria deaths are no longer a normal part of life in Africa. **\$10 = one bed net = one life.**

Our youth and children will be raising money for Imagine No Malaria in the next few weeks. Please prayerfully consider how we can MULTIPLY their efforts. Imagine if every member in our church saves 10 lives!
