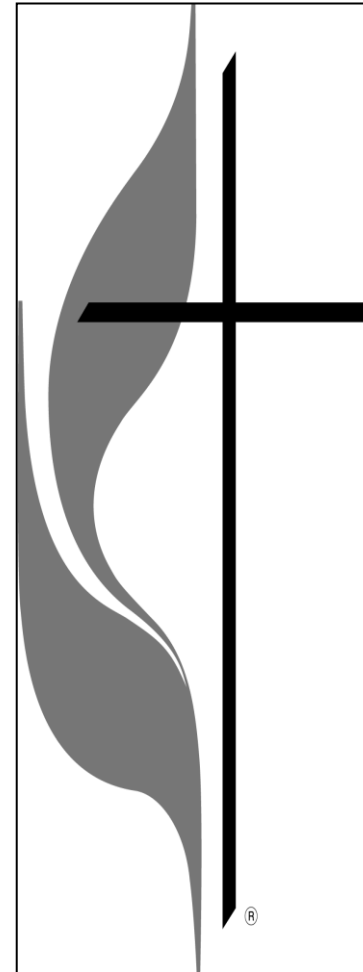

Every 30 seconds, an innocent child in Africa dies of malaria.
