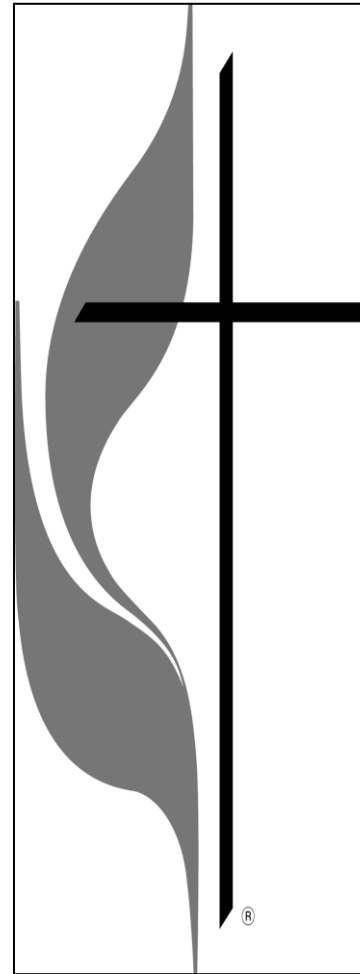

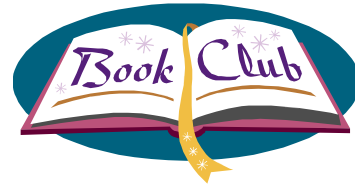
No DOJO June 27 or July 4 due to Mission Camp. We will resume July 11.
